PTA Annual General Meeting 3 March, 2023, 2pm Minutes



1. Attendees: Mrs Roberts, Jen Fisher, Lorraine Duffett, Sally Lloyd Davies, Claire Forrester, Hazel Spencer

2. Treasurer Update – Claire, Treasurer, shared the Treasurer update. Currently in the bank account there is £6016.75. Since Sept 2023 we have taken in just over £200 from Amazon Smile and Bags for Charity, £1630 from PTA fundraising events and £564 from 100 club. We have spent £343 GBP for PTA and School Purchases

3. 100 Club Update – Sally, 100 Club Coordinator, shared the 100 club update. There are 65 numbers assigned. More people have joined than left so far this school year. The annual income at current level of assigned numbers: £480. There has been a change to the rules this year – each month we draw from all 100 numbers, if the number drawn is not assigned then that month's £25 rolls to next month's winner.

4. PTA Funding Principles – Sally shared a written document of the new principles, the team agreed to put the principles in place. To ensure all parents, carers and staff are aware of the new PTA Funding Principles, we will upload a copy to the school's website in PTA news and laminate a copy and put on the new PTA notice board. The PTA Funding Principles take effect immediately.

5. Student Council Suggestions Update – Mrs Roberts, Head of School, shared the Student Council update. Mrs Roberts has not met with the team this half

term. As a PTA team we discussed the recycling / composting issue the student council had raised. Mrs Roberts informed us the student council will be writing a letter to Ash Disposal to ask what happens with the trash and recycling – their question is: are they recycling? Mrs Roberts shared that the Owl's classroom has a new recycling bin in their class, and there is now composting outside for fruit waste. Next actions: Mrs Roberts will work with student council to write the letter to find out about our current recycling situation, we will then look into next steps.

Trim Trail Flooring: our current top item on our purchase list is the flooring for the trim trail in the front playground. Mrs Roberts will be getting an updated quote. We will dedicate the sponsored circuits to raising funds for the flooring.
